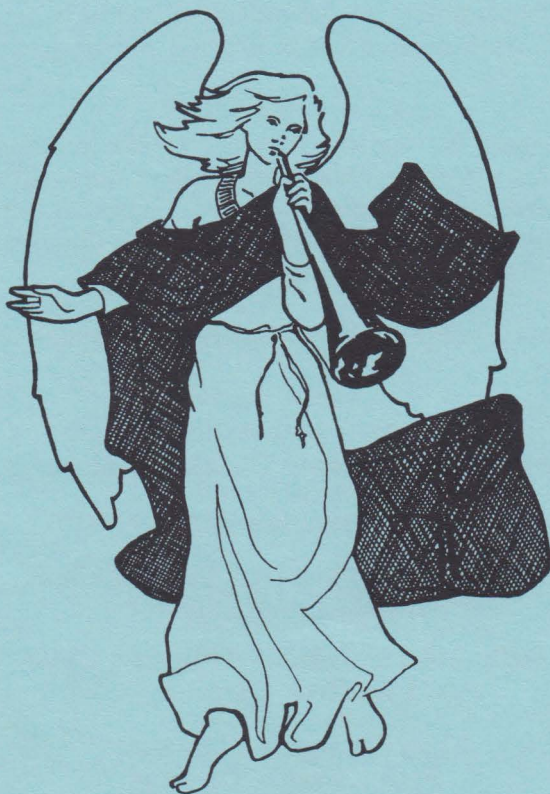

“Lessons and Carols” is not old, as English traditions go. It was first instituted in the new West Country diocese of Truro in 1883 and soon spread to other cathedrals and finally, in 1918, to its most famous home, Cambridge University. There, in King’s College Chapel, it remains a nearly essential part of the English celebration of Christmas. The BBC has carried the service on its world service for many years, and recently American Public Broadcasting stations have made it available on TV and FM radio in the U.S.

“Lessons and Carols” came to Willamette in 1985, when it was held in the Old Waller Auditorium with a volunteer choir. The service was held in the Cat Cavern for several years, until returning to Cone Chapel in Waller Hall in its present form in 1989. Now, in a kind of Willamette Christmas Eve, before exams and vacation separate us, we have the opportunity of hearing the story of redemption read by representative members of the Salem and campus communities and of hearing and singing popular carols of Christmas.

Our Thursday evening service this year takes place in Salem’s First United Methodist Church. We are grateful for the hospitality of the staff and congregation. Meeting at First Church both permits more people to be part of our service and recalls the continuing link of the United Methodist Church and Willamette University and our historical link to this particular congregation.
