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

2. Glee will be presented with one basic formation in each class.
3. Participants shall not change their relative position during the singing of the song.
4. All participants in the formation must march, or count time until the formation is completed.
5. After the formation is complete, the participants may stop for no more than 10 seconds.
6. Judging will start when the participation class is announced and the judging shall end when they return to their seats and all have been seated.
7. No stage properties, nor change in appearance of wearing apparel is permitted. A stage property shall be any item other than the original costume.
