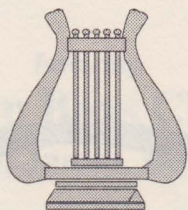

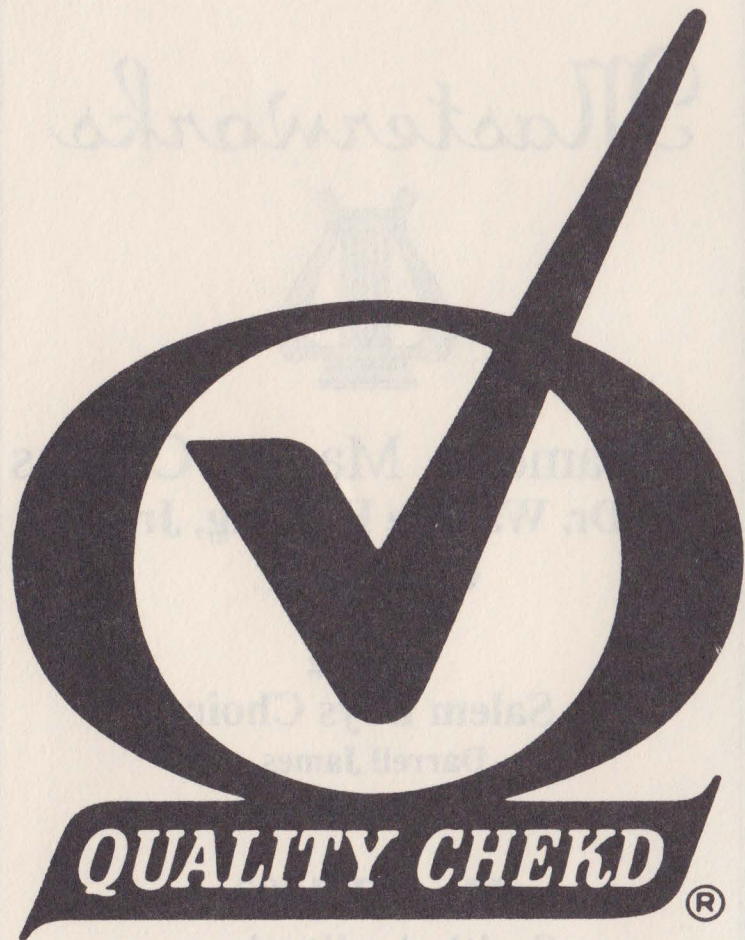

Willamette Master Chorus

The choir was established as a joint effort by the Salem community, *Willamette University*, and a grant from the *Lutheran Fine Arts Council* to develop an organization devoted to excellence in choral music. After six years as the **Willamette University-Community Choir**, the organization has become the **Willamette Master Chorus**, still maintaining a close affiliation with Willamette University.

Members, now 80 strong, are drawn from the ranks of both professional and non-professional musicians in the greater Salem area. Concert literature is chosen from master-works from the Renaissance through the 20th Century.

Dr. Wallace H Long, Jr.

Director of Choral Activities at Willamette University since 1983, Wallace Long excels as conductor, educator and musician. In addition to conducting the University's choral ensembles, he has numerous teaching responsibilities, and he is involved in community and professional groups, most notably the Male Ensemble Northwest.

Wallace received his master of music degree and his doctorate in choral conducting from the University of Arizona at Tucson, where he studied with Maurice Skones, Jean Berger, and David Wilson. A bass/baritone soloist, studio recording musician, and a frequent vocal/choral adjudicator and clinician, Wallace is an active supporter of public school music in the Northwest.

Wallace has been conductor of the Willamette Master Chorus since the group's inception in 1984. Under his inspirational leadership the group continues to reach further levels of choral excellence.
