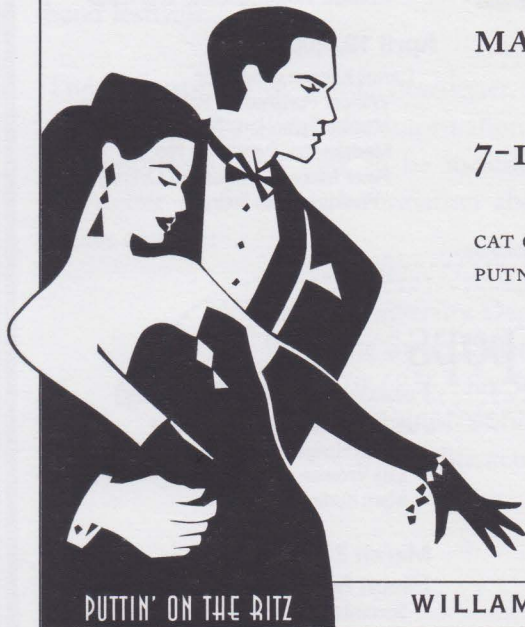

He is a frequent clinician, adjudicator and festival conductor and has served in a variety of administrative positions for various organizations. As a bass vocalist, Long has been a member of the Robert Shaw Festival Singers (a professional chorus composed of 60 individuals chosen through an international audition process). He is also a member and co-director of Male Ensemble Northwest (a 12-voice professional choral organization that performs throughout the region).
