Awarding of Edith Findley Brydon Prize

Edith Findley was born July 26, 1911 in Grants Pass, Oregon. The Findley family moved to Salem in 1914. Their generous support of the arts in the Salem community was shown through donating a pipe organ to the Salem Methodist Church. In high school, Ms. Brydon studied piano and accompanied the glee club. Following her graduation, Ms. Brydon completed her music degree at Willamette University, where she studied with Virginia Melton. She accompanied the Men's Chorus and soloists, and presented junior and senior recitals. In 1932 Ms. Brydon taught music and American History at Hillsboro High. In 1934, upon moving to Berkeley, California, Ms. Brydon directed and accompanied a community chorus at the San Francisco Senior Center. Returning to Salem in 1970, Ms. Brydon directed and accompanied choruses at the Salem Senior Center and continues to accompany for the Capitol Manor Men's Chorus in Salem.
