# Beastro "short" support in senate

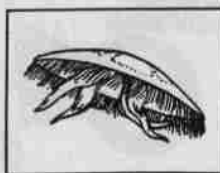

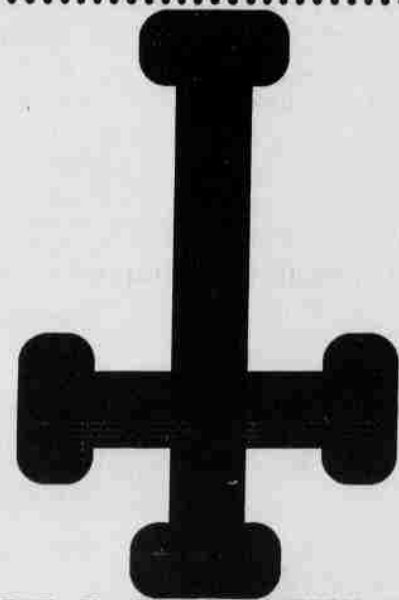
