A Service of Nine Lessons and Carols was instituted in the new Cathedral of Truro, Cornwall in 1883 and was quickly adopted by other Anglican churches as a simple and beautiful celebration of Christmas Eve. Since 1918 it has found a special home at King's College Chapel, Cambridge, from which it has been broadcast by the B.B.C. around the world.

Willamette University began *its* tradition of "Lessons and Carols" in 1985, when it was held in the old Waller Auditorium with a volunteer choir. For several years it was held in the Cat Cavern, and then returned to Waller Hall and the renovated Cone Chapel in 1989. Scheduled at the end of classes, before exams and vacation separate us, it gives the Willamette community an early opportunity to hear the Christmas story of redemption (read by representatives of the Salem and campus constituencies), to hear glorious anthems, and to sing together popular carols.

This year we extend the range of our service by offering it twice (Wednesday at the convocation hour and Thursday evening) in the new Hudson Concert Hall of the Mary Stuart Rogers Music Center. Friday evening we return to the service's traditional venue in Cone Chapel.

Following the service, collection plates are available for an offering on behalf of Marion-Polk Food Share for the hungry of our community.
