


















Student Leadership




















Victory for Frosh and Willamette at Homecoming














Lady's Game






Football


ANDERSON AND MAZE

All-Star defensive team, but also was picked for the Associated Press 22-man Little All-American team. Also picked for the N.W.C. All-Star first team were: defensively, mod, Stan Traxler; guard, Walt Looney; halfback Walt Maze.

The defensive honors went to end Bruce Anderson and Linebacker Ronnie Lee. Honorable Mention offensively were tackles, Dean Popp and John Travis; guard, Dick Takei, and fullback Jack Deja. On defense were guard, Carmy Mausten; tackle, Rich Kawana, and safeties, Billy von Arnswaldt and Spike Moore.

27 Willamette 6 Nevada

Bearcat gridders amazed skeptics and thrilled supporters by putting together a spirited defense and playing a crushing ground game to beat the University of Nevada with apparent ease in a 27-6 upset. The win was even more impressive in view of the fact that only four Willamette grid teams since 1952 have won their season's inaugural.



7 Willamette 32 Linfield

The Willamette football team that lost to Linfield 32-7 looked very different from the team that had played Nevada and Humboldt. Jim Dombroski swept the end for the only Willamette score. It appeared that the Bearcats could not tackle and few passes were broken up by the Cat defenders in this encounter.





Willamette Humbolt

Things looked tough for the Willamette team in their second game of the season, but they edged the favored Humbol Lumberjacks 6-0 with Walter Maze's 58-yard touchdown run. The final score was maintained by the stubborn defenses of both teams.



33 Willamette 6 Puget Sound

With Tom Edwards at Quarterback the Bearcats dominated the entire game to hand University of Puget Sound a 33-6 Defeat. The Bearcats defense held UPS to a minus 48 yards, a new Northwest Conference record.



0 Willamette 14 Lewis and Clark

The Willamette Bearcats have gone three years without bearing Lewis and Clark. On Lewis and Clark's first play from scrimmage, Quarterback Jim Thomas threw a long pass to Larry Burgess making a great 66-yard touchdown combination even though the ball was deflected by Spike Moore. Lewis and Clark went on to defeat the Bearcats 14-0.





14 Willamette 21 Pacific

The passing arm of Pacific University's Dick Wiese tipped the scales in favor of the Badgers in a nearly equal football game with the Bearcats. The Bearcats were threatening to even up the 21-14 score as time ran out. WU's loss, their third straight conference defeat, put them in an unfamiliar position at the bottom of the league standings.

Quarterback Tom Edwards made only two pass completions, but they were of the "Iong bomb" variety, good for two tallies that proved to be the deciders in Williamette's 20-14 conquest of the Whitman Missionaries. The win was WU's first in the current NWC race and inspired continued Bearcat possession of the Paul Bunyon Ax.

A Willamette Homecoming crowd saw the Bearcats crush College of Idaho 34.7 at McCulloch stadium with an outstanding performance by the entire team. The game was highlighted with the scoring of three touchdowns by Walter Maze, with Jack Deja and Spike Moore tallying one apiece. 




Wrestling
