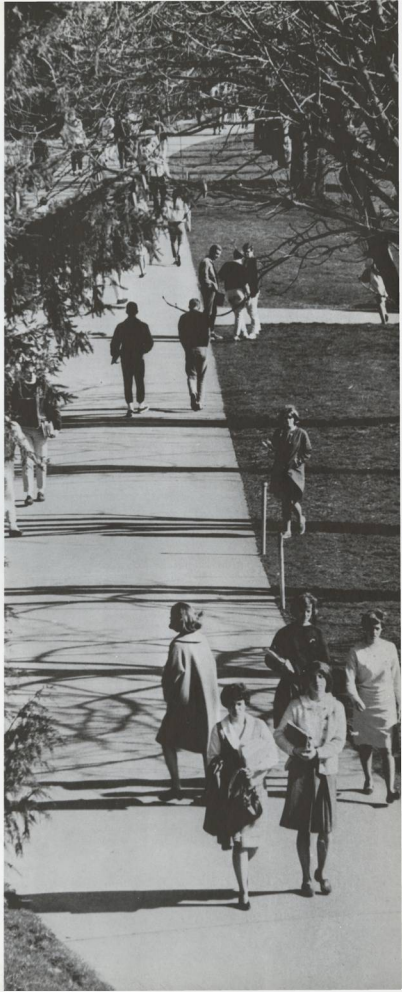


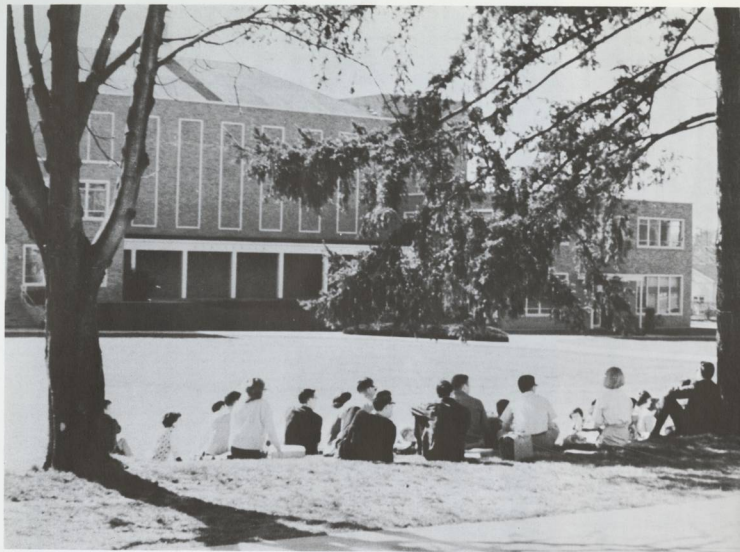


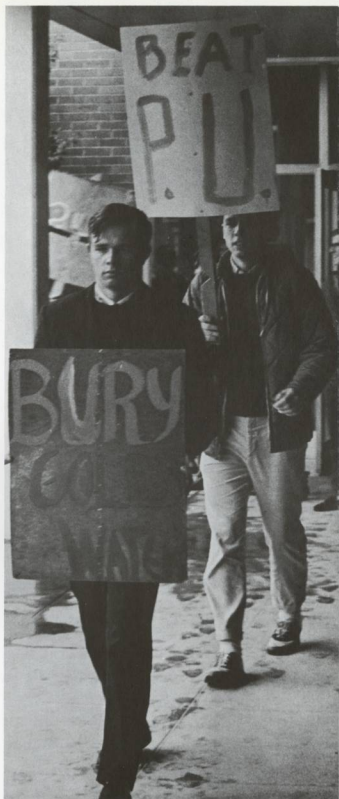














Student Leadership

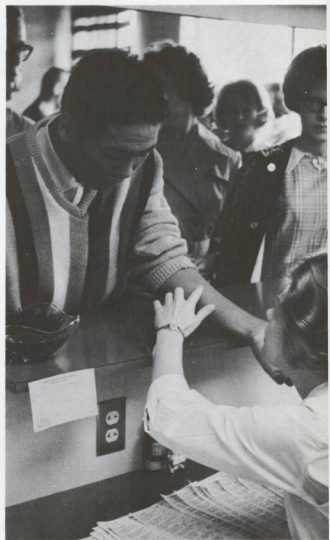




Registration

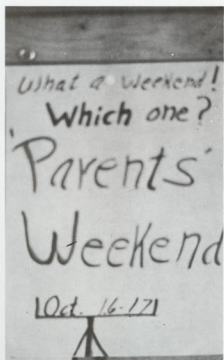
Parent's Weekend

Victory for Frosh and Willamette at Homecoming



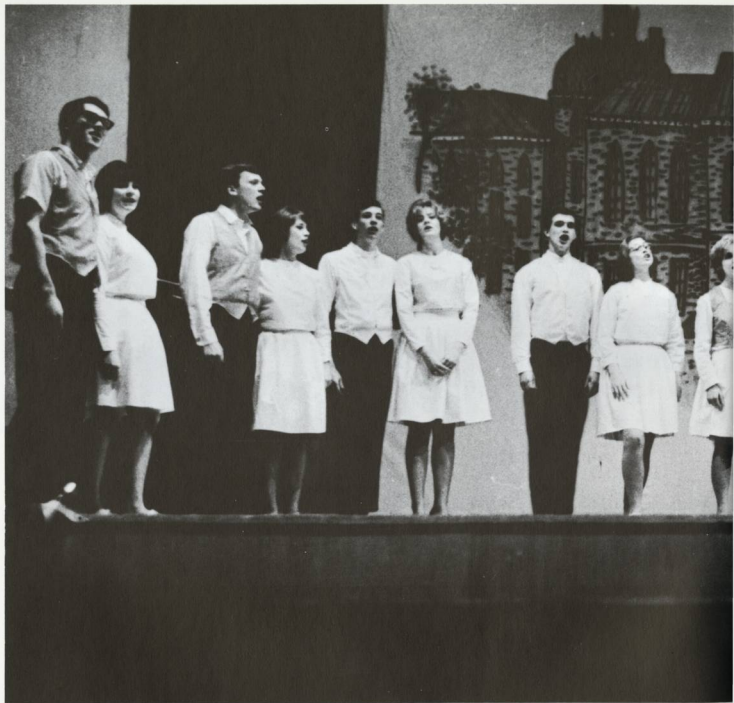

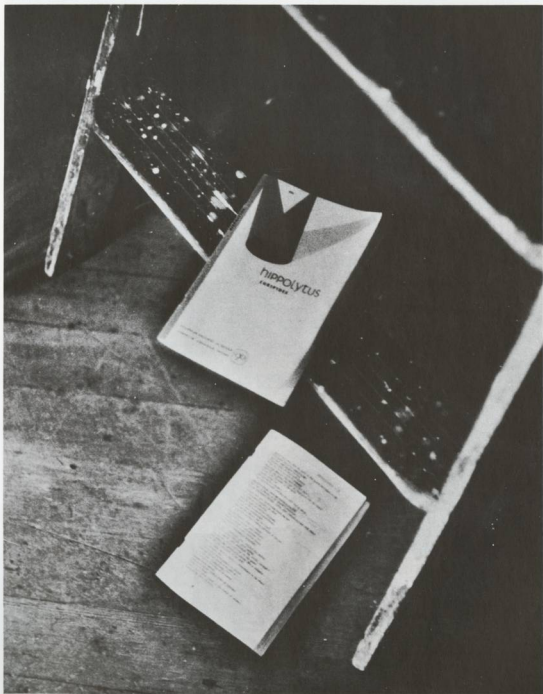
Hippolytus

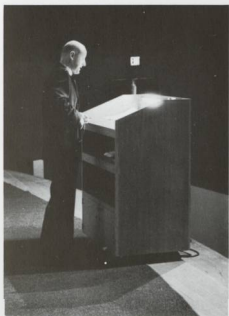

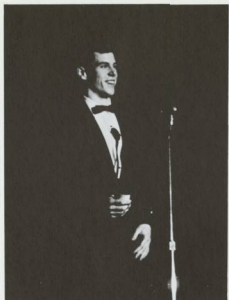




Dave Brubeck

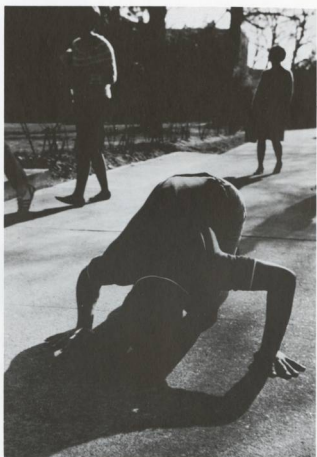


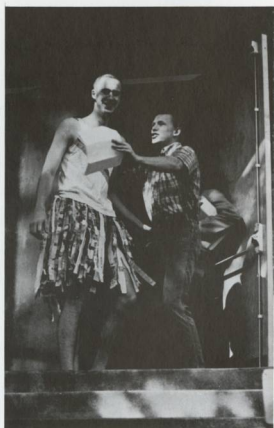


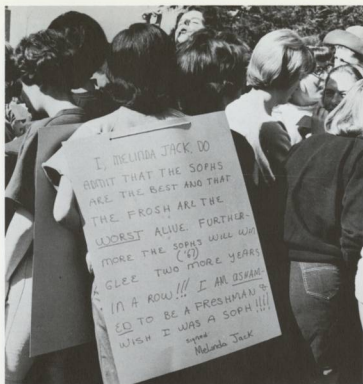
Freshman Glee

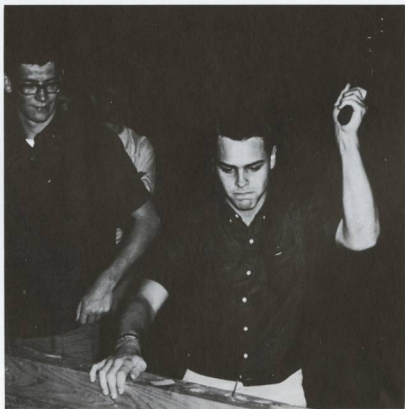


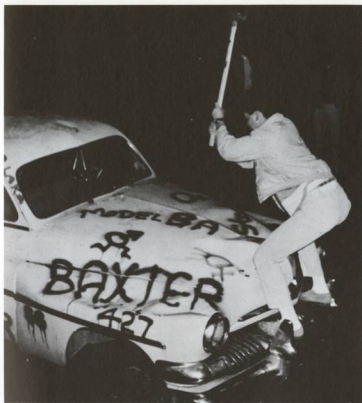






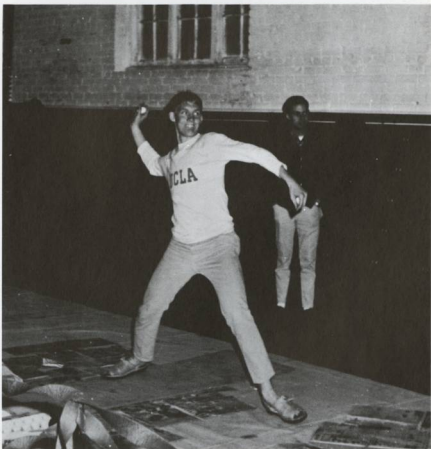






AWS Carnival

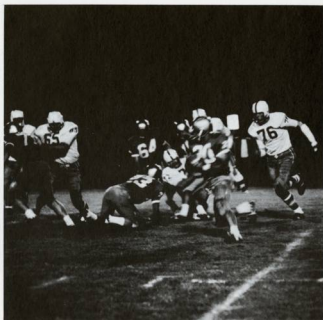
ANDERSON AND MAZE

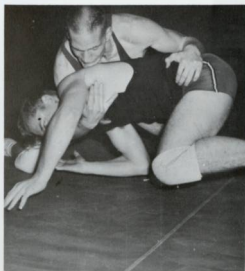
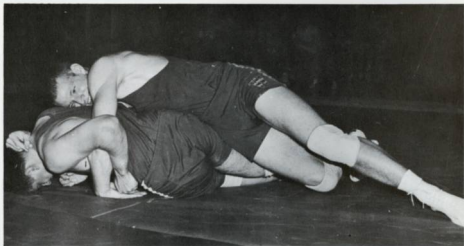


Wrestling

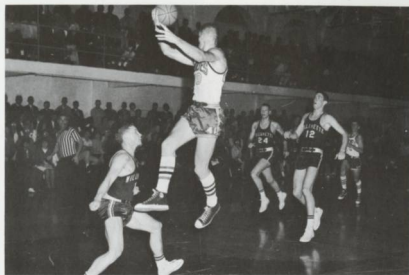
Varsity Basketball

Yunker, and Dave West.

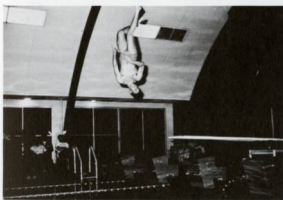

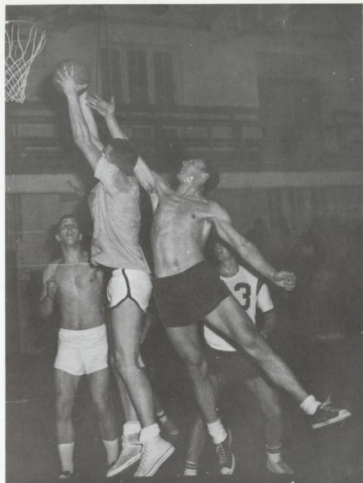


Rugby

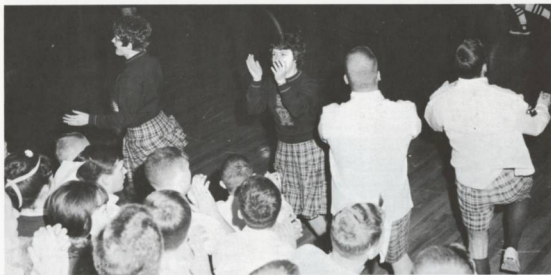


Intramurals
