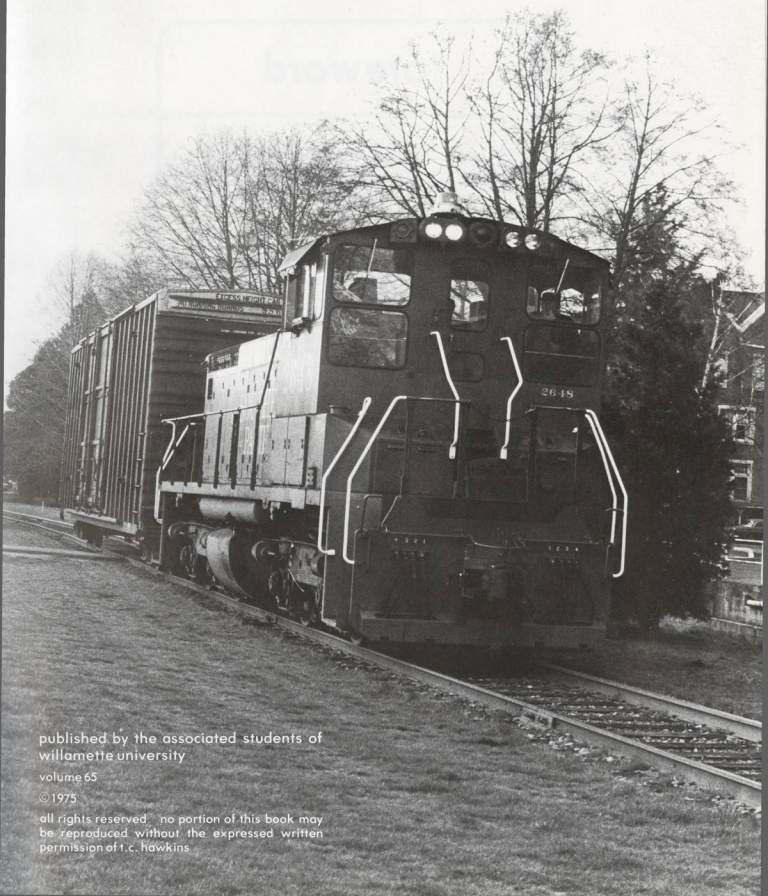

the story of wallulah

there has been some inquiry as to the origin of the name of the annual, the "wallulah." of course all who are familiar with the indian legends of oregon, and particularly with balch's, "the bridge of the gods," appreciate at once the significance of the name, and its peculiar relation to the name of the university. according to tradition, wallulah was an indian maiden, the daughter of old multnomah, the powerful chief of the wallamets, (which is the original spelling of the name) the tribe which occupied this section of the pacific northwest, and which held many other tribes under subjection. this was in the days when the fabled bridge of the gods spanned the columbia at the place which is now known as the cascades. an ancient prophecy said that the power of the wallamets should be unbroken as long as the bridge stood.

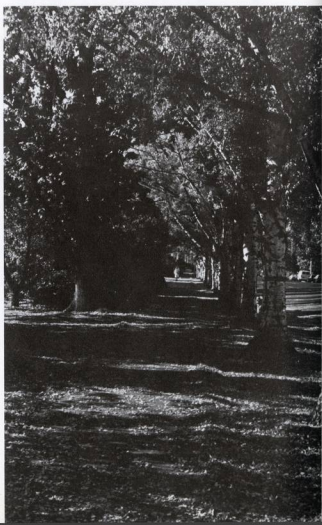
cecil gray, a white man, came out from the east as a missionary to the indians, and the beautiful wallulah fell in love with the pale face. but, although he loved her, he felt that he could not be true to his mission if he married her, so he forced himself to give her up. his work stirred up much animosity among the redskins, so much indeed, that he was finally condemned to death by a council of the chiefs; but according to the story the great spirit took him before the ordeal.

troubles began to arise for the wallamets, and at the same time a volcanic disturbance arose, during which the great bridge fell. this was taken as a sign from the gods, and the power of the wallamets was broken. wallulah was given to a cayuse chieftain, snoqualmie, a man whom she hated. while he was taking her up the columbia to his tribe, the canoe was capsized in the newly-formed rapids at the cascades, and the unhappy wallulah was drowned.

the director of health services, dr. ralph purvine, died on october 4, 1974, after 34 years of dedicated service to the university.

michael cho, of kailua, hawaii, was a freshman at willamette and a reserve member of the varsity football team. on october 19, 1974 he suffered a severe neck fracture in a conference game against whitworth college of spokane.

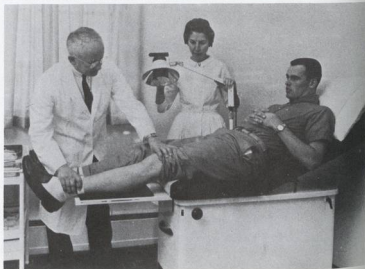
the '75 wallulah staff takes pride in acquainting the entire willamette community with these two people who have given so much of themselves to the university.

in this building dr. purvine really began to develop health services on the campus. he worked here (right) until 1956.



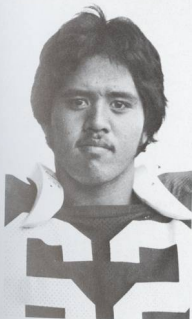

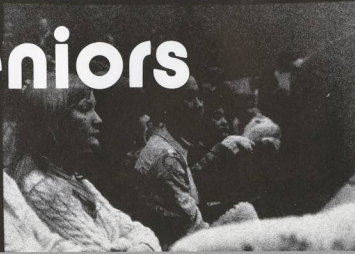
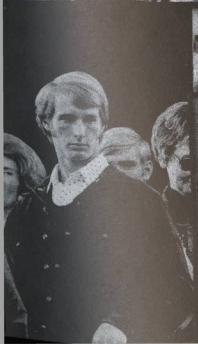


the '75 wallulah is also dedicated to michael cho. cho suffered a fractured and dislocated neck while on a routine blocking assignment against the whitworth pirates.

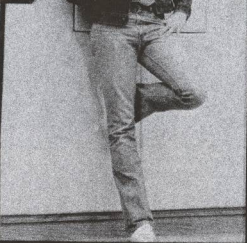
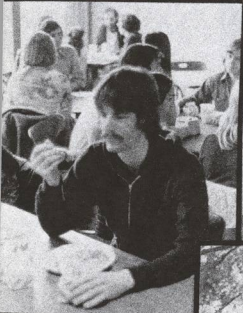
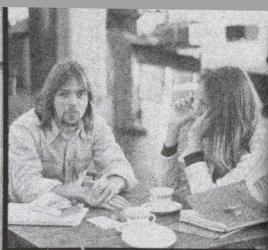
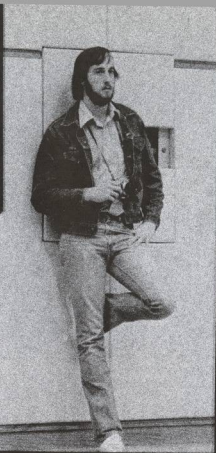

without either lover or carnival.

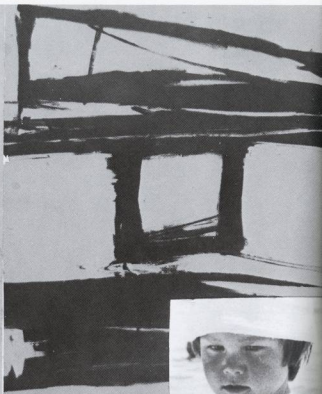
oh "omlette with sprouts and soy grits,"

and out of ourselves.

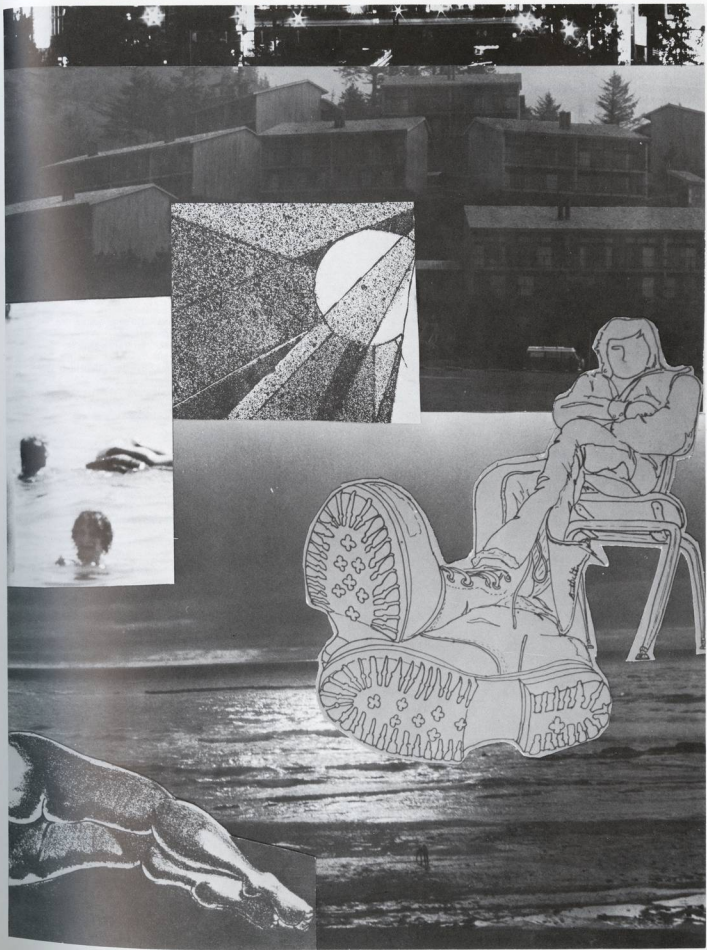

a rippling stream.

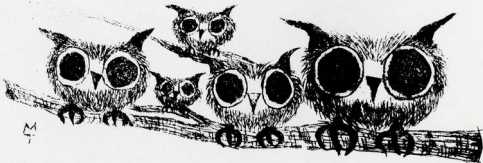

i didn't feel lucky.

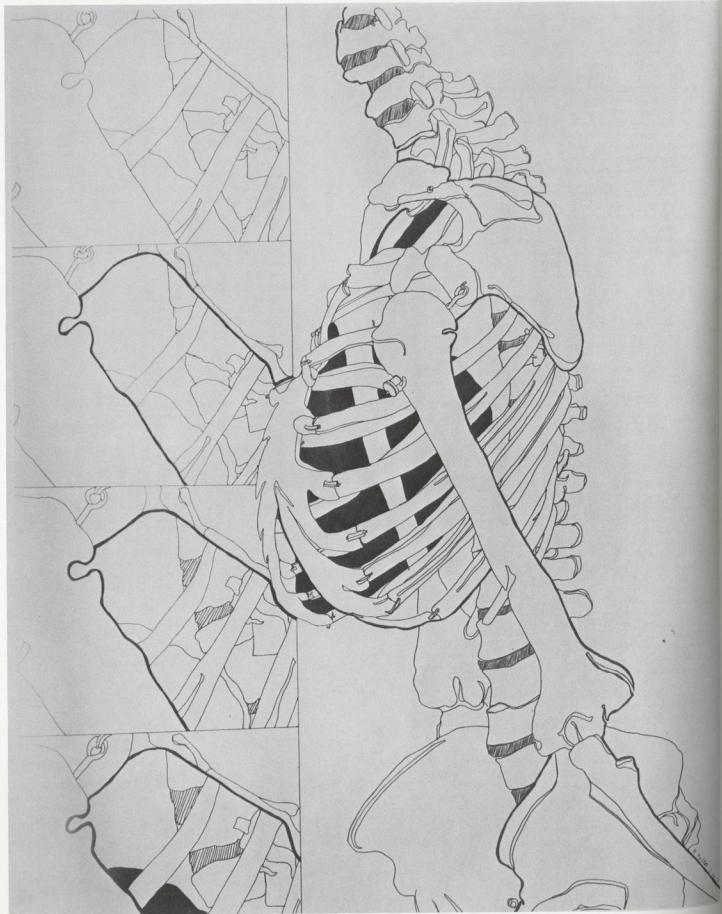

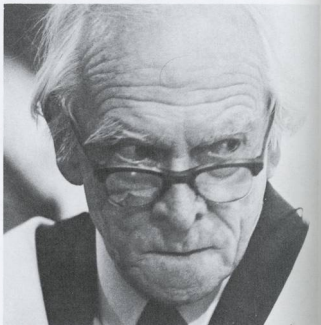


dr. alan paton

"I believe in the cooperation of nations." such were the words of the distinguished south african author, dr. alan paton, during his visit to willamette university. brought to the campus for the week of nov. 19-23, under the auspices of the atkinson fund, dr. paton's visit was highlighted by the bestowal of a honorary willamette degree in humanities for his efforts to achieve justice for all men.

heralded to international fame by his books on race relations in south africa and his own personal experience as a dissenter against the apartheid system, dr. paton spoke to the willamette community on the need for racial harmony and international cooperation within the world at large.

the week's activities included an evening of paton's readings; a two day lecture series providing a historical and contemporary analysis of south africa and concluded with involvement in a "convocation on peace and self development."



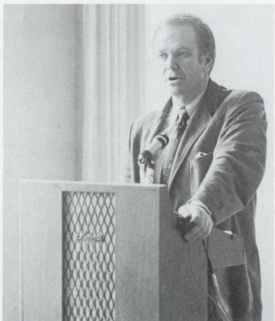


elliott richardson



former attorney general elliot richardson, appearing in behalf of candidate senator bob packwood, broadened his lecture and discussion before a willamette audience into the topic of political morality. serving previously in such positions as secretary of h.e.w. and secretary of defense, richardson resigned in his last capacity as attorney general for his refusal to fire watergate special prosecutor, archibald cox.

speaking in reference to the watergate episode, richardson advocated that "openness and candor" should be the biggest aims of our political system. such qualities would discourage corruption and dishonesty, since "conscience is the inner voice that tells you someone is watching."



kenneth



dolbeare

on january 22, kenneth dolbeare, noted political author, came to willamette university for a series of lectures and seminars. presently a professor at amhearst, dolbeare is known for such works as "american ideologies" and "political change in the u.s."

in discussing the possibility of revolution in america, dolbeare explained that he referred to "changing the fundamental outlines of the social order." dolbeare predicted the decline of economic individualism and liberalism which has only resulted in "a great international economy devoted to profits." foreseeing the possible substitutes, dolbeare considered facism to be repulsive and socialism as the only alternative. in the final analysis, dolbeare said, "you must find the future in yourselves."



milton friedman

the end of the fall semester was marked by the appearance of milton friedman, one of the outstanding conservative economists in the united states.

speaking in reference to the current economic situation, friedman defined the inflation/recession problem as one that develops in a roller coaster effect. blaming such inflation on increased spending without an accompanied raise in taxes, friedman claimed that wage and price controls are ineffective as a long run cure.

unfortunately, dr. friedman offered no ready solution and, indeed, predicted that the united states is not near the end of its economic problems.





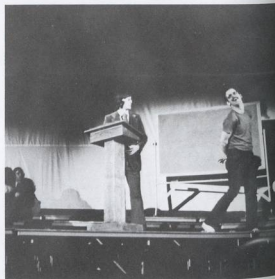
glee

freshman glee, begun in 1908, is a tradition designed to bring together the university community and forge better relations among that group. classes compete against each other, based upon three criteria: words and music, marching formation, and vocal rendition.

freshman glee, held in the spring, lasts six days, with practices beginning on monday and glee night the following saturday.

this year, glee was held for the first time in sparks center and was dedicated to the man for whom the athletic facility was named: lester j. sparks. this year's theme was "today" and the sub theme was "where do we go from here?"

this year's results were the closest in recent memory, the sophomores and seniors tied with a total of 21 points but the class of 1977 was awarded first place based on their four first place votes to the seniors three. the juniors were third, with 26 points, and the freshmen earned the right to walk the millstream with 33 points.

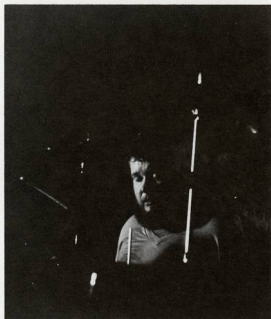




rare earth

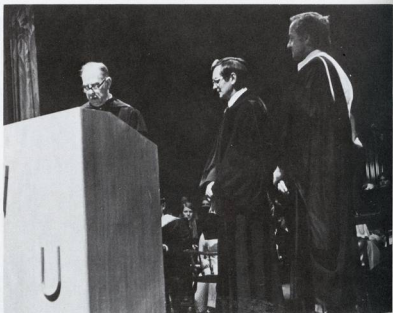


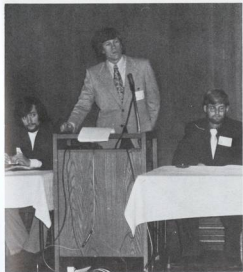
presidential inauguration

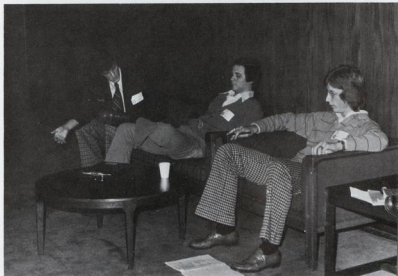
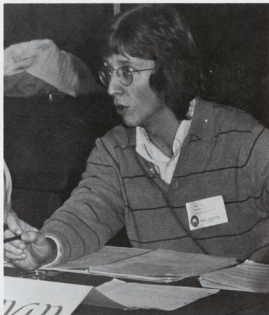




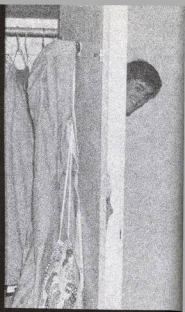
willamette students have participated in two model security councils in preparation for the western model united nations being held in fullerton, california this april. the first session was held at oregon state in november.

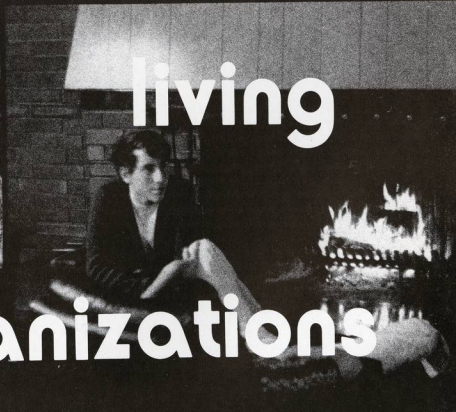
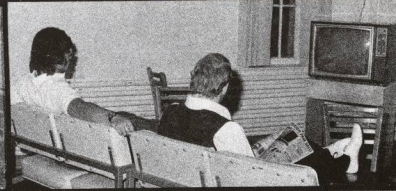
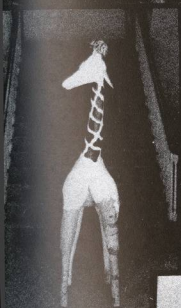
