His is to be feared above all gods.


Duo Seraphim

DR. JOSEPH WYTKO

We are pleased this evening to have as our guest soloist, Dr. Joseph Wytko. A recipient of the prestigious Solo Recitalist Fellowship from the National Endowment for the Arts, Dr. Wytko is currently Professor of Saxophone at Arizona State University, an artist-clinician with the Selmer Company, and saxophonist with the Phoenix Symphony Orchestra. He has performed solo recitals in such halls as Carnegie Recital Hall and San Francisco's Herbst Theater, and as soloist with the Pittsburgh Symphony Orchestra and the Phoenix Symphony Orchestra. Included among those orchestras with which he has performed as orchestral saxophonist are the Chicago Symphony Orchestra, the Grant Park Orchestra, and the Chicago Civic Orchestra.

Dr. Wytko has recorded on the Brewster, Orion, and ACA Digital record labels and maintains an active concert schedule which has included tours of Canada, Mexico and Guam. His disc recording of Karel Husa's *Elegie et Rondeau* (Brewster Records 1295) was labeled by the composer as "perfectly musical, first-class playing - a magnificent treat."

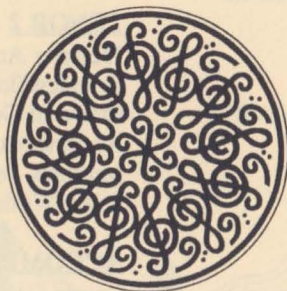
