Role: Villain

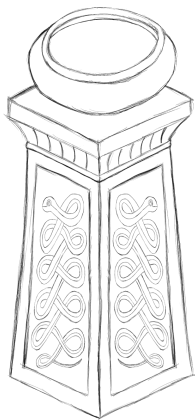
Age: Immortal

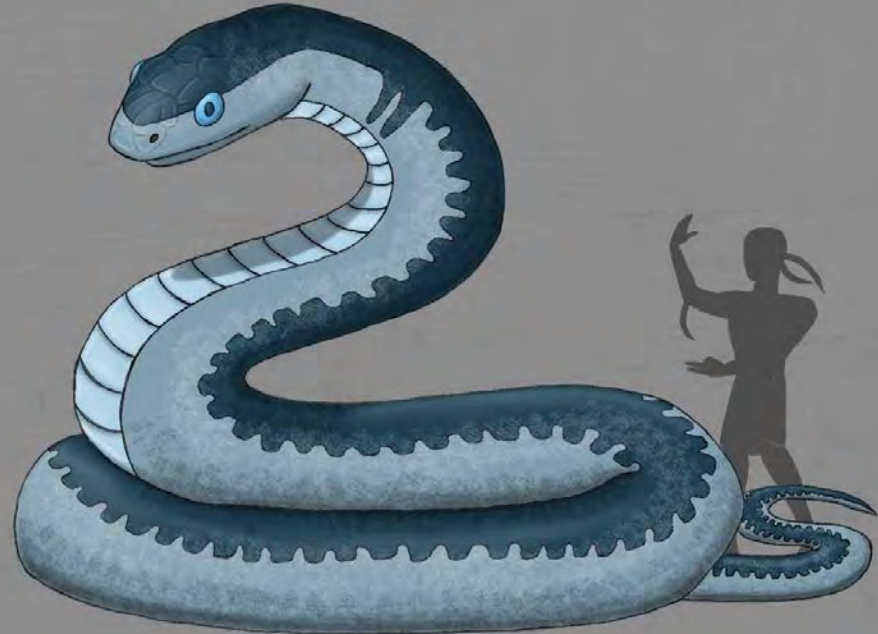

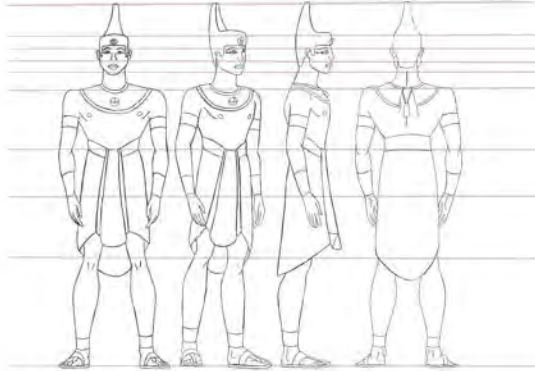

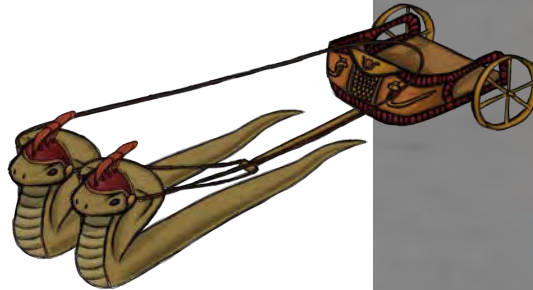

- Imhotep, Ta-Nehisi, Ramla and Thutmose call on the gods in one of the temples

Purpose/Values:

Who Lives/Works Here:

Thutmose

Character Interactions:

- Thutmose defends Ta-Nehisi and Ramla from attacking Set Animals
- Ta-Nehisi and Ramla learn the location of Nehebkau with the help of Thutmose



Nile Tribe



Purpose/Values:

- Annual flooding of the Nile through a dance ceremony
- Reverence for creation

Who Lives/Works Here:

Zahur, Naunet and Nehebkau

Character Interactions:

- Ta-Nehisi, Ramla and Naunet learn about Nehebkau in The Library of Ancients
- Naunet leads Nehebkau out of The Library of Ancients



Kingdom of the Valley



Purpose/Values:

- Preparing the souls of the dead for the afterlife
- Guiding the souls safely to The Hall of Truth

Who Lives/Works Here:

Ta-Nehisi, Ramla and Menes

Character Interactions:

- Ta-Nehisi and Ramla explore Khufu's Pyramid on their first mission as Soul Guardians
- Ta-Nehisi and Ramla ask for Pharaoh Menes' blessing before heading out on their quest for Nehebkau
- Pharaoh Menes gathers all the mummies as they prepare to defend Egypt from Apep



The Duat



Purpose/Values:

- Gateway for souls to find their fate in the afterlife
- Judged based on their moral choices in the mortal world

Who Lives/Works Here:

Ta-Nehisi, Ramla, Osiris, Thoth, Ma'at and Anubis

Character Interactions:

- Ta-Nehisi and Ramla escort the soul of Pharaoh Khufu to the Hall of Truth
- Keket and Apep escape the Duat with their army



Apep's Lair



Purpose/Values:

- Place where Apep was banished during the Age of the Gods
- Villain lair for scheming, summoning and sacrificing

Who Lives/Works Here:

Keket, Apep and Set Animals

Character Interactions:

- Ta-Nehisi and Ramla spy on Keket sacrificing a soul to Apep
- Keket sends Set Animals to ruin Ta-Nehisi and Ramla's plans
- Keket builds an army from the bodies of souls fed to Apep



Episode 1 – The Hall of Truth

- Ta-Nehisi and Ramla explore Khufu's Pyramid as their first mission in order to retrieve The Book of the Dead and escort Khufu's soul to the Hall of Truth. After they leave the pyramid they run towards a portal created by Ta-Nehisi that connects the living world to the realm of the Duat.
- There in the Duat Ta-Nehisi and Ramla ride the Solar Barque to the Hall of Truth following the instructions of The Book of the Dead. Upon arriving at the Hall of Truth Ramla notices one of the souls getting abducted while Ta-Nehisi escorts Khufu into the line. Both Ta-Nehisi and Ramla go after the abducted soul to find a secret lair dedicated to Apep the chaos serpent.

Mid Arc Episode – A Change of Heart

- That night Ta-Nehisi and Ramla report to Pharaoh Menes in his throne room about their findings on how to stop Apep. They ask Pharaoh Menes for permission to travel to Lower Egypt in order to visit Pharaoh Thutmose to gain insight on the location of Nehebkau and he approves.
- Meanwhile in Upper Egypt Pharaoh Djoser has a vision in the form of a nightmare about Keket tipping the scales of Ma'at by releasing Apep. He calls for Imhotep to work out a plan with him. Imhotep suggests another council meeting and this time to invite Ta-Nehisi and Ramla. Pharaoh Djoser heeds Imhotep's suggestion and makes plans for invitations to be sent out.
