Freshman Glee is judged in three major categories: musical composition and lyrics, vocal rendition, and marching and formation. Musical composition and lyric scoring is based on originality, coordination and adaptibility to the Glee theme, and overall impact of the song. Vocal rendition is judged on expression, tone quality, and musicality. Marching and formation is judged on precision, originality, and total effect. The judges award points for each of the three areas using an established point system. The class accumulating the most points will be the winner of Freshman Glee; the losing class will walk the millstream for more marching practice on Blue Monday.

In our work as Glee Managers, a new and challenging experience faced us. In our effort to make Glee not just a show but a production, we had many people supporting us, advising us, and assisting us. To these people we are grateful.
