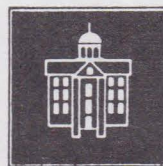

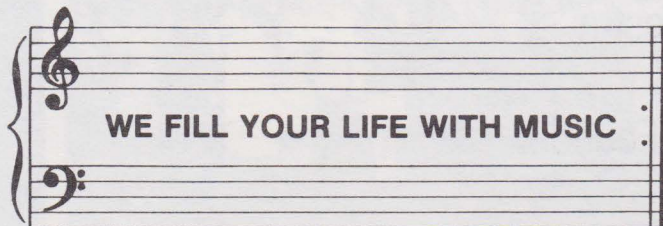

## Our Conductor

**Dr. Wallace Long, Jr.**, Willamette University Director of Choral Activities since 1983, excels as a conductor, an educator, and a musician. In addition to conducting the University's five choral ensembles, he has numerous teaching responsibilities and is involved in community and professional groups, most notably the Male Ensemble Northwest.

Wallace received his master of music degree and his doctorate in choral conducting from the University of Arizona at Tucson, where he studied with Maurice Skones, Jean Berger, and David Wilson. Prior to coming to Oregon he taught choral music for six years at Santa Rita High School in Tucson, Arizona.

A bass/baritone soloist, studio recording musician, and a frequent vocal/choral adjudicator and clinician, Wallace is an active supporter of public school music in the Northwest. He is a member of the OMEA, MENC, NAJE, NATS and serves the Oregon Chapter of ACDA as a member of the executive council representing Oregon colleges and universities.

## Our Soloists

### Soprano

**Valerie McIntosh** has been teaching award-winning singers and thrilling Salem audiences with her own singing since her arrival in the area in the fall of 1969. While she is best known recently for her sensitive performances of the 18th century music with the Musicke Consort, she performs music of all ages in concert, opera and recital. For the past year she has taken a leave from teaching at Willamette University to pursue a Doctorate of Musical Arts at the University of Oregon where she continues her vocal studies with Ann Tedards. She continues the line of singer/teachers with whom she has studied which includes Richard Miller and Nancy Zilstra.

### Alto

**Margret Tlustos** is a native of Portland and holds a vocal degree from Lewis and Clark College. She has appeared with the Oregon Symphony, Oregon Ballet Theatre, Choral Arts Ensemble, and Portland

**Opera.** A frequent Bach soloist with the Community Music Center Choral singers, she was selected as a Fellow to the 1991 Back Aria Festival and Institute in Stoney Brook, New York. Tlustos is currently the alto soloist at First Presbyterian Church in Portland.

## Tenor

**Karl W. Helton** makes his second appearance as soloist in the "Messiah Sing-Together." Since his first performance in the Fall of 1989, he has been awarded first place winner in the National Association of Teachers of Singing student competition in the Spring of 1990, and sang in Willamette Community Orchestra's performance of the "Messiah" later that year. In the Spring of 1991, he soloed with the Portland Chamber Orchestra after being awarded first place winner in their 1990 solo competition. Earlier this year, he presented a joint recital with soprano, Kimberly Goodwin-Helton, sponsored by the Portland Opera Guild, performed in the first Rossiniana concert organized by Robert Feist, portrayed the character of Sam in Portland State University's production of Floyd's "Susannah," and most

recently sang in Willamette Community Orchestra's performance of Bach's "Magnificat." Karl remains an active Portland opera chorus member and sang the character Nemorino in the opera's preview concerts of this season's "L'Elixir D'Amore."

## Bass

Portland baritone **David Jimerson** has sung leading roles in over 35 operas throughout the Northwest (Portland and Seattle Opera) as well as in Anchorage, Nevada, Arizona and in concert with the Oregon Symphony, the Tuscon Symphony, the Grand Rapids Symphony, as well as at the Peter Britt Festival and with the Portland Symphonic Choir. An extensive list of oratorios and concertworks are part of his career as well as acclaimed recital appearances. Among his major roles are those of Alfio in *Cavalleria Rusticana*, Tonio in *Pagliacci*, Germont in *Traviata*, Count di Luna in *Trovatore*, the title role in *Gianni Schicchi*, Schaunard in *La Boheme*, Figaro in *The Barber of Seville* and Enrico in *Lucia di Lammermoor*. Mr. Jimerson is Voice Professor at Portland State Univeristy and active in concerts and opera in Portland.

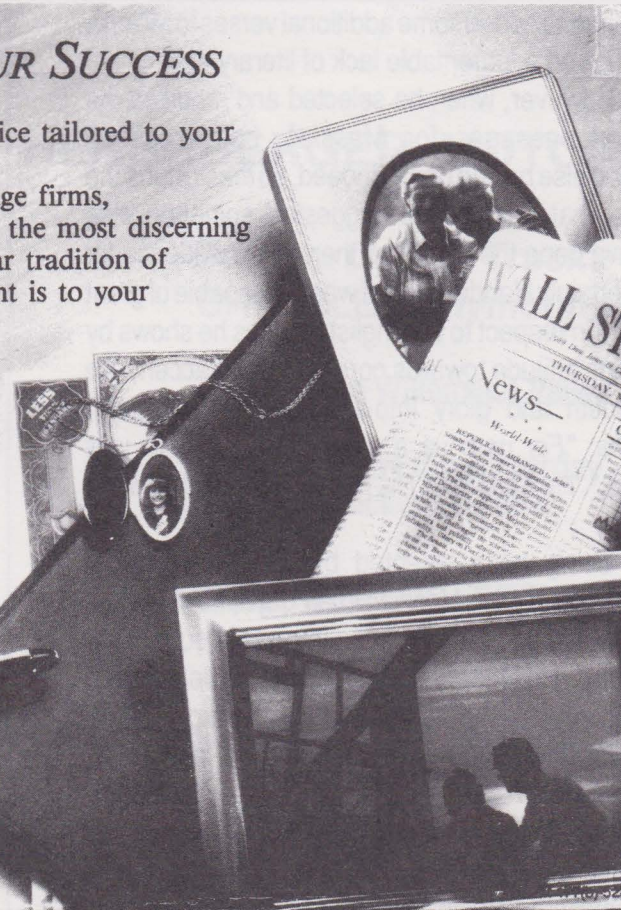
