## Willamette University Jazz Ensemble

The Willamette Jazz Ensemble is a 17-piece group open to all University students on an audition basis. Since 1982, the group has hosted the annual Willamette University Jazz Festival, bringing together high school jazz bands from the Northwest and bringing to Salem some of the top names in jazz.

The band has backed such jazz greats as John McNeil, Bud Shank, Pete Christlieb, and Bobby Shew as well as the legendary Dizzy Gillespie. The Jazz Ensemble has been invited to perform at the Northwest College Band Directors National Association Conference and at several conferences of the Oregon Music Educators Association. Campus and local performances as well as periodic Northwest tours complete the performance schedule of the ensemble.

At the core of the band program is the University Band, a 45-piece ensemble open on an audition basis to all Willamette University students. With regularly scheduled rehearsals during the week, the University Band performs on campus, in local high schools, and on tours in Oregon and adjacent states. It has also been invited to play at the Northwest College Band Directors National Association Conference and the Oregon Music Educators Conference.
